1.Choice Plus Checking: A minimum of \$500 is required to open a Choice Plus Checking account. No minimum balance is required to earn dividends, but a \$5 fee will be charged any month during which the balance falls below the minimum on any given date. The minimum balance of \$500 is required to obtain the disclosed Annual Percentage Yield (APY).

2.Choice Preferred Checking: A minimum of \$2,500 is required to open a Choice Preferred Checking account. No minimum balance is required to earn dividends, but a \$5 fee will be charged any month during which the balance falls below the minimum on any given date. The minimum balance of \$2,500 is required to obtain the disclosed APY.

*To receive the \$50 bonus, the checking account must be opened with a qualifying direct deposit. A qualifying Direct Deposit is a Direct Deposit of your salary, pension, Social Security, or other regular monthly income electronically deposited into your account by your employer or an outside agency. Direct Deposit must be initiated within 60 days of opening a Choice Checking, Choice Plus or Choice Preferred Checking Account to receive the \$50 bonus.
